Battersea Power Station bags 'Developer of the Year' award in London

KUALA LUMPUR: The redevelopment of the Malaysian-linked Battersea Power Station was handed the "Developer of the Year" award at the 2015 international Emirates Glass LEAF awards ceremony in London recently.

The Leading European Architects Forum (LEAF) awards panel reviewed entries from around the world and judged the Battersea Power Station to be the most compelling nomination for the Developer of the Year category, said Sime Darby Property in a statement here, yesterday.

Battersea Power Station, owned by a Malaysian consortium comprising S P Setia, Sime Darby, and the Employees Provident

Fund, was also shortlisted for the Best Future Building category.

Battersea Power Station Development Company Chief Executive Officer Rob Tincknell described the award as an incredible honour.

"Thanks to the vision and determination of our shareholders, the boundless potential that lies on this central London, riverside site, is finally being unlocked.
