# SP Setia wins three awards

Five other Malaysian developers win awards at FIABCI World Prix d'Excellence Awards 2018

**DUBAI:** For the first time a Malaysian developer, SP Setia Bhd, has bagged three Gold awards for three projects at the FIABCI World Prix d'Excellence Awards 2018.

This is the first time that a developer has won so many global awards for its projects in one night.

Apart from SP Setia, five other projects by five Malaysian developers also won Gold awards for various categories at the same event.

There were 13 categories for the

Gold FIABCI World Prix d'Excellence Awards this year, and of that, the six Malaysian companies bagged eight awards.

"For SP Setia to win three awards is unprecedented, it is also the first time even in the history of FIABCI. To us, we have worked very hard and are happy to be honoured... it is an achievement by our team," SP Setia president and chief executive officer Datuk Khor Chap Jen said after receiving the awards in Dubai on Tuesday night.

He added that for so many Malaysian companies to win awards in the different categories proved

that "if they put their heart and soul into it" especially for single projects, "they can be world beaters."

The three awards won by SP Setia are for FIABCI World Gold awards in the Affordable Housing Category for the Seri Kasturi Apartment project in Setia Alam; Master Plan Category for the Setia Eco Glades project in Cyberjaya; and Sustainable Development Category for the Eco Sanctuary project in Singapore.

This win and being a 10-time winner of the FIABCI Malaysia Property Awards would further bolster SP Setia's position as a rep-

utable world-class developer, Khor said.

SP Setia's previous international FIABCI Prix d'Excellence award wins span best master plan developments for Setia Eco Park, Setia Eco Gardens and Setia Alam, best retail development for Setia City Mall, best residential (low-rise) development for Setia Eco Park and the unique 28-acre park complex, Eco Greens at Setia Eco Gardens, took home the award for the best purpose-built/specialised project category. The group's corporate headquarters in Setia Alam was also awarded the Gold Award in the

Sustainable Development Category in 2016.

The other Malaysian winners are Mangala Resort & Spa, Pahang for environmental (rehabilitation conservation). Gamuda Bhd won the same award for Yen So Sewerage Treatment Plant/Yen So Park in Vietnam, Eco Business Park 1 in Johore (industrial category) by Eco World Development Group Bhd, Socso Tun Razak Rehabilitation Centre-Malacca (purpose built category) by Anuar Aziz Architect, and 16 Quartz Melawati (residential low-rise category) by Mitraland Group.
